### MAIN APPLICATIONS AND TIPS FOR CORRECT USAGE

For permanent overlap splices at rereelers and for temporary splices at sheeters.  
The tape can be stored for maximum 12 months from the date of production in dry conditions and in its original packaging.  
The material should be protected from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.  
Once removed from its original packaging, the tape should be protected from dust and other impurities. Keep the rolls in horizontal position.
